ORDER AMENDING DECISION
AND DENYING REHEARING

Petition for rehearing of Decision No. 69419 having been filed by Pomona Valley Water Company, the Commission having considered said petition and each of its allegations, and being of the opinion that no good cause for rehearing has been made to appear, but that certain amendments should be made therein,

IT IS ORDERED that the following amendments be made in Decision No. 69419, to read as follows:

1. At line 13, page 4, "This system is supplied from Ranch's Wells Nos. 2, 3 and 9A and a hydropneumatic pressure tank."
2. At line 19, page 4, "This system provides service north of Lake Los Serranos and along Eucalyptus Avenue."
3. At line 16, page 14, ". . . applicant shall file with the Commission four copies of a comprehensive map drawn to an indicated scale of not more than 600 feet to the inch, . . ."
4. After line 9, page 15, add the following paragraph:
 "11a. Applicant shall file with the Commission a water supply permit from the appropriate public health authorities, pursuant to General Order 103, Paragraph II."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 69419, as amended herein, is hereby denied.
