SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southwest Gas Corporation on October 5, 1965 requested in writing an extension of the terminal date of Special Condition F to its tariff Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, from October 13, 1965 to December 31, 1966, in order to complete the entire project as authorized by Decision No. 68008, dated October 13, 1964. The Special Condition was authorized for a period of one year.

It appearing to the Commission that the extension should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit for the application of said Special Condition F of applicant's tariff Rule No. 15 is hereby extended to and including December 31, 1966, subject to Southwest Gas Corporation filing in accordance with General Order No. 96-A, revised tariff sheets, reflecting the authority granted hereby, such filing to be effective on one day's notice to this Commission and to the public.

In all other respects Decision No. 68008 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
