SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 69695, dated September 21, 1965, the Commission authorized John Howard (seller), an individual doing business as Morrow Water Company, to transfer his water system to the City of Ceres (buyer), and to discontinue service. The decision provides that the order therein will become effective upon further order of the Commission, to be issued after receipt of certain stipulations by buyer to protect the interests of customers outside the city boundaries.

On October 1, buyer filed with the Commission, in compliance with the requirements of Decision No. 69695, the requisite stipulations.

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of this order, and of the order in Decision No. 69695, shall be the date hereof.
