ORDER

City of Santa Fe Springs is hereby authorized to construct Sorensen Avenue at grade across the track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6C-14.95, in the City of Santa Fe Springs, County of Los Angeles.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between the City of Santa Fe Springs and the Pacific Electric Railway Company. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Width of the crossing shall be 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
