BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades whereby Pomona Free-) Application No. 47753 way (State Route 60) will be carried (As Amended) over tracks of the Union Pacific Rail-) road Company in the City of Industry, referred to as "Clayton Overhead".

ORDER

State of California Department of Public Works, in connection with the improvement of State Route 60 (Pomona Freeway), is hereby .authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades over the tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, to be identified as "Clayton Overhead" (Crossing No. 3-14.3-A), in the City of Industry, County of Los Angeles, at the location as described and in the manner as shown in the application.

Clearances shall be in accordance with requirements of General Order No. 26-D except that the vertical clearance shall be not less than 23'-8" above top of rail. However, during the period of the construction of the "Clayton Overhead", a clearance of 22'0" above top of rail is authorized, and the Union Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues and files with the Commission appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with

plans of the separation structure approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
