ORDER REJECTING FILINGS AND DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

Southern California Gas Company desires to withdraw the suspended tariff sheets under Advice Letter No. 609, Part B, having directed a letter dated September 15, 1965 to the Commission for this purpose.

By joint letter of October 1, 1965, Southern California Gas Company has advised that on or before October 29, 1965 it will submit proposed tariff schedules in lieu of Advice Letter No. 609, Part B, and Southern Counties Gas Company of California has advised that it will submit proposed tariff schedules on or before October 29, 1965.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9203-G through 9274-G, inclusive, and 9282-G through 9287-G, inclusive, 9290-G, and 9291-G are rejected and this proceeding is discontinued.
