OPINION AND ORDER

By this petition, California Trucking Association seeks to have the third-class, less-truckload exception rating named in Minimum Rate Tariff No.2 (MRT No.2) on Toilet Preparations, Drugs, Medicines and Other Articles canceled on all such commodities described therein except military or traveling toilet kits.¹ Petitioner requests that common carriers be directed to establish in their respective tariffs such modifications as may be prescribed by the Commission's order in this proceeding, including relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code.

Petitioner states that the third-class, less-truckload exception rating is based on a released value of the property not exceeding 50 cents per pound per article. It is alleged that, under the

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 is subject to the provisions of National Motor Freight Classification A-8(CAL), as governed by National Motor Freight Classification A-8, collectively referred to herein as the Governing Classification. The rating in question supersedes the rating otherwise applicable under the provisions of the Governing Classification and is set forth in Item No. 395 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

provisions of the Governing Classification, the commodities in question are also subject to a third-class, less-truckload rating based on released value provisions which are the same as those now set forth in MRT No. 2. Petitioner avers that, since the aforementioned classification provisions are now applicable in California, the need for an exception rating in MRT No. 2, which is duplicated in the Governing Classification, is no longer necessary. Accordingly, petitioner proposes that MRT No. 2 be amended so that the exception rating therein will apply only on military or traveling toilet kits. It is asserted that such revision will result in neither increases nor reductions.

Copies of the verified petition were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and carrier representatives on or about July 30, 1965. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 3, 1965. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

Except as hereinafter specified, the Commission finds that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and the resulting minimum rates will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation of the commodities involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The proposed cancellation of the exception rating on shampoo would permit a higher first-class, less-truckload rating in the Governing Classification to apply inasmuch as shampoo is not subject to the released value provisions of that tariff. Such an increase has not been justified. We conclude that the petition should be denied with respect to the proposed cancellation of the exception rating on shampoo and that, in all other respects, it should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 27, 1965, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than November 27, 1965.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

5. Petition for Modification No. 390 in Case No. 5432 is denied insofar as the cancellation of shampoo from Item No. 395 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 is concerned.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
