ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 65475 dated May 28, 1963, in Application No. 45438, Charles T. Cohen was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between the Edgewater Motel, Corte Madera, Marin County, and Oakland International Airport, Oakland, Alameda County, and it appearing that during the month of November 1963, Charles T. Cohen without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between Corte Madera and Oakland International Airport pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since October 31, 1963, Charles T. Cohen has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-A, and that Charles T. Cohen has expressed his desire to discontinue service due to lack of public demand for the service; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 65475 in Application No. 45438, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Charles T. Cohen are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Charles T. Cohen or to mail a certified copy thereof to Charles T. Cohen at Box 401, Tiburon, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 20th day after such service upon Charles T. Cohen or after the above mailing to Charles T. Cohen, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
