ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVENESS OF TARIFFS

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having filed on September 14, 1965 the above-entitled application to revise and extend certain tariffs which otherwise would expire on November 7, 1965; a hearing having been held and the matter having been taken under submission; and it appearing that a temporary extension of present tariffs is necessary pending issuance of a final decision; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the effectiveness of applicant's tariff Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 122-T and sections designated "Rates" C., D.1., and O. of applicant's tariff Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 45-T, is hereby extended from November 7, 1965, to November 26, 1965, unless otherwise hereinafter ordered.
