Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., requests authority to discontinue operation as a public utility warehouseman at Mendota and Richfield.

It is alleged that the facilities have not been utilized for nonproprietary storage since 1961; while applicant has continually held out these facilities for public storage, the only storage since 1961 has been proprietary; there are other adequate facilities in the immediate vicinity of applicant's facilities and potential storers have been notified of the proposed discontinuance and have registered no objection.

After consideration the Commission finds that granting of the application would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., may discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman in Mendota and Richfield.

2. Appendix A attached to Case No. 6704 dated August 1, 1960 is hereby amended by substituting Second Revised Appendix A attached hereto.

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3. After the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Appendix A TO ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION AND DETERMINING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHTS IN CASE NO. 6704.

Pacific International Rice Mills, Inc., a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of a storage or warehouse floor space as follows:
