ORDER

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a frontage road at grade across a branch line track of Southern Pacific Company in connection with improvement of State Route 29 in Napa, Napa County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AB-71.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if

public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
