ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Consumers Transportation Corporation has been suspended since May 27, 1965, for not having the required tariffs on file and in effect on January 1, 1965, the date such certificate was reinstated after having been previously suspended on a voluntary basis. To date the carrier has not filed the required tariffs.

Consumers Transportation Corporation not having the required tariffs on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier granted to Consumers Transportation Corporation by Decision No. 44392 dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31227, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Consumers Transportation Corporation or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Consumers Transportation Corporation or after the above mailing to it, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
