ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT By Decision No. 62694 dated October 17, 1961, as amended by Decision No. 62974, dated December 27, 1961, in this proceeding, Vance C. Farmer was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel for the transportation of persons between Panther Creek Lodge in Requa and Johnsons and all intermediate points upon and along the natural course of the Klamath River. Vance C. Farmer has informed the Commission by letter that he has never operated under the certificate because the boats he purchased have too great a draft to navigate the water and to perform the operation involved. He also states that he is not financially able to commence such an operation and requests that the certificate be revoked. No tariff is on file. In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. We conclude that the requested revocation should be granted. IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel granted to Vance C. Farmer by Decision No. 62694, dated October 17, 1961, as amended by

Decision No. 62974, dated December 27, 1961, in Application No. 43625, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Vance C. Farmer, or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Vance C. Farmer or after the above mailing to him, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
