ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Leonard A. Kinzel has been suspended since April 28, 1965, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance and was continued in suspension on July 1, 1965, for failure to have on file the required tariffs. To date the carrier has not filed the required evidence of liability insurance or tariffs.

Leonard A. Kinzel having failed to have on file the required evidence of liability insurance and tariffs, the Commission finds that such failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to Leonard A. Kinzel by Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 29, dated June 23, 1964, as amended by Decision No. 67742, dated August 25, 1964, in Application No. 46530, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Leonard A. Kinzel or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Leonard A. Kinzel or after the above mailing to him, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
