O P I N I O N

Public hearing was held before Examiner Power in San Francisco on September 29, 1965. McKenney was notified but did not attend.

After a reasonable wait for McKenney to appear the staff was allowed to proceed. It presented evidence that McKenney, in an attempt to qualify as a household goods carrier, had taken examinations on June 22 and 29, 1965. Applicant made scores of 20% and 22%, respectively. At the time of the first examination applicant was warned against taking the second so soon after the first.

The Commission finds that applicant has failed to establish his ability to operate as a household goods carrier as required by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code.

The Commission concludes that the sought permit should not be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 47716 be, and it is, denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
