O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Trimble Road near the City of San Jose in Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DA-47.30-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 2 percent.

Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals with the two signals at the shoulders supplemented with automatic gate arms and the center two signals placed on raised median strips. Back lights may be omitted on the median signals. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that applicant will construct the track only to the northerly line of Trimble Road and install a temporary bumper near the southerly line of said road, so as to prohibit use of the track across the road until such time as the crossing is to be used for rail service.

Installation of the automatic protection for this crossing may be deferred until such time as there is a need for the temporary bumper to be removed so that the proposed track may be placed in operation, and installation shall be made prior to removal of the temporary bumper.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
