ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

It appearing that on August 31, 1965 the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation which suspended the effective date until November 29, 1965 of certain tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 1614, reflecting a revision of the Schedule No. A-36, by the General Telephone Company of California because of a protest received. Such protest having been withdrawn and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The investigation instituted to determine whether said tariff sheets are unreasonable or unlawful in any particular is hereby terminated.
2. The rates, classification, practices or rules in the tariffs filed by Advice Letter No. 1614 shall be refiled.
3. General Telephone Company of California is authorized to file the same tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 1614 under a new advice letter, to become effective on November 29, 1965, in conformity with the provisions of General Order No. 96-A.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon General Telephone Company of California.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
