ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING EFFECTIVENESS OF TARIFFS

IT IS ORDERED that the effectiveness of applicant's tariff Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. 122-T and sections designated "Rates" C., D.1., and O. of applicant's tariff Schedule Cal. P.U.C.

No. 45-T, is hereby extended from November 26, 1965, to January 28, 1966, unless otherwise hereinafter ordered.
