SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 69994, entered today, the Commission found, among other things, that certain changes should be made in Item No. 400 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B and that such tariff should be amended by separate order. The changes result in neither increases nor reductions in rates.

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 19, 1966, the revised pages attached hereto, and by this reference made a part hereof, which revised pages are numbered as follows:

- Fourth Revised Page 6
- Fifth Revised Page 30
- Original Page 30-A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the sixtieth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
