ORDER

The City of San Buenaventura is hereby authorized to abandon and barricade Montgomery Avenue, (also known as Bristol Road), Crossing No. BE-405.2, and to establish concurrently a new grade crossing approximately 150 feet to the east at the location described in the application, to be identified as Montgomery Avenue, Crossing No. BE-405.3, in said city.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement to be entered into between the City of San Buenaventura and the Southern Pacific Company. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs of construction and maintenance by further order.

Width of the crossing shall be 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
