## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 69469 dated July 27, 1965, in the above proceedings, certain zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 were modified and transferred to Minimum Rate Tariff 17. It has come to the Commission's attention that the application of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 does not clearly reflect the modification of such rates. The necessary clarification will be made by the order herein.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective January 1, 1966, Fourteenth Revised Page 4 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. In all other respects Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
