present lines.

O P I N I O N

San Mateo-Burlingame Transit, doing business as Bayshore Transit Lines, requests authority to extend its Hayward-San Mateo Route so as to provide service to a new subdivision area in San Mateo County known as Foster City.

It is alleged that the new area will ultimately have a population of 35,000.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 67278 in Application No. 45660 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 4 attached hereto in place of Original Page 4.
2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariff and timetable presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

## SECTION 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS

Route E. Beginning at Third Avenue and B Street, thence along Third Avenue, Delaware Street, Fourth Avenue, Grant Street, 16th Avenue, Delaware Street, Bermuda Drive, Ginnever Street, 19th Avenue, Norfolk Street and Third Avenue to its intersection with B Street.

Also from the intersection of 19th Avenue and Norfolk Street, thence along Norfolk Street, Hillsdale Boulevard, El Camino Real, 19th Avenue Freeway and Hillsdale Boulevard to the College of San Mateo; thence along Hillsdale Boulevard and Norfolk Street to its intersection with 19th Avenue.

Route I. Beginning at Third Avenue and B Street, thence via B Street, 4th Avenue, El Camino Real, Hillsdale Boulevard, Edison Street, 37th Avenue, Alameda de las Pulgas, Ralston Avenue, El Camino Real to Hillsdale Boulevard.

\*Hayward-San Mateo Route - Commencing at Watkins and B Street in the City of Hayward, thence via Watkins Street, Jackson Street, West Jackson Street, San Mateo Bridge, Foster City Boulevard, East Hillsdale Boulevard, to El Camino Real, Fourth Avenue, B Street to terminal at Second Avenue.
