## FIRST SUPPICMIENTAI OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 69854, dated October 26, 1965, The ftchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company was authorized to construct an additional main track at grade across Orangethorpe Avenue, in the City of Anaheim, to be identified as a portion of Cxossing No. $2 B-41.8$.

The order provided that such crossing shall be protected by two Standard No. $\varepsilon$ flashing liglat signals (supplemented by automatic crossing gates) to be installed at the edge of the street, plus two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (without backlighes) to be located on the median islands.

The order should have provided for protection by three Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (supplenented by automatic crossing gates), plus one Standard No. 8 flashing light signal.

Good cause appearing, II IS ORDERED that with the instajlation of the additional main track aczoss Orangethorpe Avenue, Crossing No. $2 B-41.8$, such crossing shall be protected by three Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (supplemented by automatic crossing gates), two to be installed at the edges of the street and one (without
baciclights) to be located on the wester median island. In addition, one Standard No. 3 flashing light signal (without baclilights) shall be located on the caster median island.

In all other respects Decision 1:0. 69354; is in full force and effect.
