In the Matter of the Application of HECTOR PEDROZA, an individual, dba PEDROZA MOVING, cf San Francisco, for a permit to operate as a household goods carrier (Appln. No. 38-7841-HG) within a 50-mile radius of San Francisco, (File No. T-82,221).

OPINION

Hector Pedroza filed this application for a household goods carrier permit. He was given an examination, as required by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code. Applicant failed to pass this examination. However, according to the staff member who examined him, he has an adequate knowledge of the hourly rates.

As required by Section 5135 a public hearing was held at San Francisco before Examiner Power on November 9, 1965, and the matter was submitted.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that applicant meets the requirement for issuance of a permit, provided that such permit is restricted to service between points within fifty constructive miles of his headquarters in San Francisco.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as provided by the following order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission is authorized and directed to issue a household goods carrier permit to Hector Pedroza containing the following restriction:

"Applicant shall not perform any transportation service under this permit where either the point of origin or the point of destination is more than 50 constructive miles (as indicated by Distance Table No. 5) from San Francisco."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
