Investigation into the safety, maintenance, operation, use and protection of the following crossing at grade with the line of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Los Angeles, Crossing No. B-479.3-C San Fernando Road State Highway No. 4.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 69201, dated June 28, 1965, Southern Pacific Company was ordered to install the following automatic protective devices at the crossing at grade on San Fernando Road (Legislative Route 163) at Frederick Street, in the City of Los Angeles (Crossing No. B-479.3-C):

- (1) Two cantilevered Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (with modifications) on San Fernando Road.
- (2) One Standard No. 8 flashing light signal on the northerly curb line of Frederick Street east of San Fernando Road.

Since the hearings in this matter were held, it has been found that the City of Los Angeles does not own property of sufficient width along the northerly curb line along Frederick Street adjacent to the crossing to permit installing a Standard No. 8 flashing light signal. In addition, a fence has been constructed three feet in back of the face of that curb. Frederick Street makes a "T" intersection with San Fernando Road. A stop sign is posted on the northerly curb of Frederick Street east of the railroad track in question to

control traffic turning off Frederick Street on to San Fernando Road. Vehicle traffic on Frederick Street is nominal. The cantilevered signals on San Fernando Road at the crossing will provide warning to vehicles turning off San Fernando Road on to Frederick Street as well as through vehicles on San Fernando Road.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all reference to the installation of a Standard No. 8 flashing light signal and apportionment of costs thereof on the northerly curb line of Frederick Street at Crossing No. B-479.3-C of Southern Pacific Company shall be deleted from the order in Decision No. 69201. ✓

In all other respects Decision No. 69201 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
