ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 69778

Southern Pacific Company, having filed a petition for modification of ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 69778 herein, dated October 13, 1965, so as to extend to March 4, 1966 the time specified by said ordering paragraph 4 to negotiate an agreement with the owners of the John Layous & Sons Ranch for reconstruction and protection of the private grade crossing involved in this proceeding, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 4 of said Decision No. 69778 be and it hereby is modified to the extent only that Southern Pacific Company and the owners of the John Layous & Sons Ranch may have to and including March 4, 1966 to negotiate an

agreement substantially in compliance with the provisions of the order in said Decision No. 69778. Except as modified herein, said Decision No. 69778 shall, in all other respects, be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
