COMMISSIONER PETER E. MITCHELL DISSENTING:

The Associated Owner-Operator, Inc., and the California Trucking Association complain that the Commission has established rates solely upon the judgment of its staff without affording them the promised opportunity to test the staff's programming of basic data for computer processing to arrive at the ultimate rates.

The action of the majority is contrary to our guarantee to the parties in this case: "The proposed procedure does not, nor is it intended to, impinge upon or lessen the rights of the interested parties to examine the procedures followed in the development of the rates to be established."

Accordingly, I would allow interested parties a rehearing to review the procedures used by the staff in computer processing the rates set forth in Decision No. 69469. I have no objection to further evidence on rates for area 30-P.

I suggest any additional presentation in this matter should be consolidated with Petition No. 118, Case No. 5437, for immediate hearing and decision.
