O P I N I O N

Applicant alleges that for the last three years the revenue from this passenger stage service has not been remunerative. The gross revenue, \$620 per month, has not been sufficient to support him and his family. From this gross figure he has been unable to net any revenue for the reason that he has personally driven his bus 3,752 miles a month at an estimated cost of twenty cents per mile, resulting in a loss of approximately \$130 per month. The Commission's staff after a careful study recommends granting the application.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require a continuation of applicant's service. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On January 1, 1966, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant may discontinue all his passenger stage service.

2. Upon discontinuance of the service authorized in paragraph 1, all tariffs and timetables presently on file with the Commission in applicant's name are hereby canceled.

3. The operative rights created by Decisions Nos. 62129 dated June 13, 1961, 63986 dated July 24, 1962 and 69620 dated August 31, 1965, are hereby revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
