ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Eddie Hanks, doing business as Eddie Hanks Vacuum Truck Company, has been suspended since April 22, 1965, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance.¹

A. R. Hazan, accountant for Eddie Hanks, informed the Commission by letter, dated August 18, 1965, that Eddie Hanks sold his trucks and retired from business on March 1, 1965.

Eddie Hanks having discontinued service as a highway common carrier without proper authority, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

The certificate authorizes service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum, petroleum products and water, in vacuum-type tank trucks and trailers between points and places within 50 miles of Newhall.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier granted to Eddie Hanks, doing business as Eddie Hanks Vacuum Truck Company, by Decision No. 51059, dated February 1, 1955, in Application No. 35825, is hereby revoked.

2. Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, of Eddie Hanks, doing business as Eddie Hanks Vacuum Truck Company, is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Eddie Hanks or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Eddie Hanks or after the above mailing to him, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
