FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 67316, dated June 3, 1964, the County of Riverside was authorized to construct Vista Chino-Date Palm Drive at separated grades over Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route, in the County of Riverside, identified as Crossing No. B-594.5-A.

On or about June 27, 1965 the falsework erected in connection with this project was destroyed by fire, damaging the project, and requiring extensive corrective work. It is now necessary to reconstruct the falsework to the clearance specifications previously approved in said Decision No. 67316.

Applicant requests that the time limit within which it may exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 67316 be extended to May 1, 1966.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the County of Riverside is authorized to reconstruct the falsework of the Vista Chino-Date Palm Drive overhead crossing, under the following conditions:

Clearances shall be in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 26-D, except that the vertical clearances

shall be not less than 23 feet 8 inches above top of rail; however, during the period of construction, a clearance of not less than 22 feet 6 inches above top of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance, provided it issues and files with the Commission appropriate bulletins to trainmen and engine men advising them of the temporary impairment of the clearance conditions and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

The time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to May 1, 1966.

In all other respects Decision No. 67316 is in full force and effect.
