ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This application for a water certificate has been on file for more than a year. During that time a voluminous correspondence has been carried on and field trips have been made by Commission staff engineers.

As it now stands applicant's proposal does not comply with General Order No. 103 and the application does not conform to the area actually being served. Each count would prevent the Commission from granting a certificate. Accordingly, the application will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 47217 is dismissed.
