ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 69868AND DENYING REHEARING

Southern Pacific Company and County of Monterey having petitioned for rehearing of Decision No. 69868, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 69868 is amended as follows:

1. Finding paragraph 1 on page 5 is amended to read as follows:

"1. The grade crossings at Mile Posts 130.5, 132.3 and 95.0 over the main line of the Southern Pacific Company at those locations in Monterey County are now and for some time past have been publicly used crossings."

2. Ordering paragraph 3 is amended by adding the following sentence to that paragraph:

"Maintenance cost of the automatic protection is apportioned on the same basis, pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 1202.2."

Rehearing of Decision No. 69868, as amended herein, is denied.
