SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On April 27, 1965 the Commission granted a cement contract carrier permit to Jess Anthony Bettencourt authorizing service to nineteen counties. He now claims to have been entitled to serve Stanislaus County as well as the counties named. On request of the Secretary he submitted documentary evidence of loads hauled by him in February, March and April, 1963 to Turlock, Modesto and Keyes. Said documentary evidence will be included in the record as late-filed Exhibit No. 3 and Bettencourt's permit will be amended accordingly.

Therefore, It Is Ordered that the Secretary of the Commission shall issue an amended cement contract carrier permit to Jess Anthony Bettencourt adding points in Stanislaus County to those points which said Bettencourt is presently authorized to serve.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
