O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across "K" Street and 11th Street and at separated grade under 10th Street in Marysville, Yuba County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that "K" Street and 11th Street are not at present open to public use and travel. This order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

The crossing of 10th Street at separated grade shall be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-179.2-A. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year

unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
