In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing construction at grade of an industrial track in Newcomb Avenue in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Newcomb Avenue in the City and County of San Francisco, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Newcomb Avenue is not at present open to public use and travel. This order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
