## OPINION AND ORDER

Distance Table No. 5 contains tho basis for detommining constructive mieages in connection with the various minimum rate tariffs issuec by the Conmission. By the abovo petition, Califomia Trucking Association seeiss to revise the Fresmo Extended Area boundary description contained in the Distance Table. Petitioner also asks that common carriers be authorized to establish in their wespective tarifis such modifications as may be prescribed by the Commssion's order in this procceding, including rellef from tho long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code.

According to petitioner, the ostablishmont of extended areas in Distance Table No. 5 satisifod a neod to provide definite, certain and stable descriptions of origin and destination areas conelstent with the neods of commerce. Petitioner asserts that changing circumstances have created a neod for partial revision of the external boundary doscraption for the Fresno Extended Aroa. Petitionor avers that, curing recent years, substantial development Of industrial and commercial facilities has occurred in the CalwaMalaga District, which is contiguous to the Fresno city limits and,

Qithough the present Fresno Extended Aroa description in Distance Table No. 5 partially includes this District, the scopo and rapidity of development in this area were not completely foreseen.

The petition alleges thet the proposed revision has been discussed with interested shipper and carrier representatives and 13 desired by them. It was servec upon various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and cerrier represontatives. It wes listod on the Commesion's Daizy Cajondar of Decembor 21, 2965. It is supported by the Fresno Chamber of Commerce. No objoction has boen receivea.

In the circumstances, it appoars, and the Comission finds, that petitionor's proposal is roasonable and thet the Frosno Extended Area set forth in the suppiement attachea hereto will provido a just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory basis for computing distances for use in applying aistance rates from or to such extenced area in the applicable minimum rate tariffs and, to the oxtent that such basis will result in increases, said increases are justified. A pubile homing is not necessary. The Commission concluces that the petition should be granted.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Distanco Table No. 5 (Decision No. 66578, as amended) Is further amended by incorporating therein, to become erfective March 22, 2966, Supplement No. 12 attached hereto and by this reference made a part bereor.
2. Tarlff publications required to bo made by common carriers as a result of the order horein may be made offoctive not earlier than the tenth day after the effoctive date of this orcer on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tarifi publications shall bo made offoctive not later than March 12, 1966; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriors as a result of the order
heroin may bo mado effoctive not oariler than the tenth day after the offective date of this order, and may bo made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commiseion and to the public if filed not lator than sixty deys aftor the effective date of the distance table supplement incorporated in this order.
3. Common carriers aro authorized to adopt Supplement No. 11 to Distance Table No. 5 as a basis for computing distances for use in applying distance rates in their common carrier tarifis for the trassportation of:
(a) comoditios for which minimum ratos have not becn established, or
(b) commodities which are subject to higher rates than, or more restrictive provisions than, the minimum rates or provisions otherwise appilcabio.
4. Common carmors, in establiohing and maintaining the revisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilitios cole to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul dopartures now maintainec une er outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are horeby modified only to the extont necessary to comply with this orcor; and schedules containing the revisions pubilshed incer this authority shail make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order:
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5. In all other respects Decision No. 66578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
