Application of the CITY OF DOWNEY to)
construct a public highway across a) Application No. 47989
railroad.

ORDER

City of Downey is hereby authorized to construct Patton Road at grade across the track of Southern Pacific Company, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-495.5 in the City of Downey.

Width of the crossing shall not exceed 44 feet and grades of approach shall be not greater than two percent in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic gates. Crossing shall not be opened to vehicular traffic until such protection has been placed in service.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. The maintenance costs of automatic crossing protection shall be borne by applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
