Application of the County of Santa Clara,  
 State of California, for an order author-  
 izing construction of a crossing at grade  
 over the tracks of the Southern Pacific  
 Company in connection with the construc-  
 tion of Tully Road in the County of  
 Santa Clara.

ORDER

The County of Santa Clara is hereby authorized to construct Tully Road at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company near San Jose in Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-50.87-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than one hundred and eight feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms. Two of the signals shall be placed on raised median strips. Back lights may be omitted on the median signals.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
