ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATE AND TIME WITHIN WHICH TO TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

Prior decisions have suspended the operating authorities and tariffs of Todd Freight Lines, Inc. until March 3, 1966 and authorized a sale and transfer of the certificate held by Todd Freight Lines, Inc. to Coast Drayage on or before March 3, 1966.

On February 23, 1966, the applicants filed a petition to request that the period of suspension and time within which to make the sale be extended to April 1, 1966, due to the time required to reissue all tariffs and to have them published by a new tariff agent.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The period of suspension of operating authority set forth in ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 66377, and the period of suspension of filed tariff schedules set forth in

ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 66377 are hereby extended to April 1, 1966.

2. The time within which the operative certificate of Todd Freight Lines, Inc. may be sold to Coast Drayage is hereby extended to April 1, 1966.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
