ORDER DEFERRING EFFECTIVE DATE OF TARIFF PAGES AND SUPPLEMENT

By Decision No. 70330 dated February 8, 1966, the Commission established rules in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B to be observed by household goods carriers, pertaining to estimating practices and delays of shipments of used household goods.¹ By this petition, California Moving & Storage Association, Inc., requests that the effective date of the rules established by Decision No. 70330 be changed from April 1, 1966 to May 16, 1966.

Petitioner avers that respondent carriers are required to revise estimating forms and possible "Order for Service" and "Bill of Lading" forms. Also, a new "Information for Shippers" form must be printed. Petitioner states that the preparation of the forms, proofing, printing and distribution thereof and the schooling and training of personnel in the application of the requirements of Decision No. 70330 entail time and necessitate deferment of the effective date as requested.

The certificate of service shows that copies of the verified petition were mailed to interested parties on or about February 18, 1966. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 3, 1966. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

The Commission having considered the petition and each and every allegation therein is of the opinion and finds that the request to defer the effective date is justified.

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B (Appendix C of Decision No. 65521, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, Supplement No. 6 attached hereto, and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 65521, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
