Whenever F. L. Martin, dba F. L. Martin Trucking, engages other carriers for the transportation of property of F. L. Martin or F. L. Martin Trucking or Martin Trucking and Ready Mix or Visalia Ready Mix or Portable Ready Mix or Selma Ready Mix or customers or suppliers of said individual, companies, or corporations, F. L. Martin, dba F. L. Martin Trucking shall not pay such other carriers rates and charges less than rates and charges published in F. L. Martin, dba F. L. Martin Trucking, tariffs on file with this Commission.
