ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Prior to the filing of these five complaints, this Commission issued orders instituting investigations into the operations of Bouquet Canyon Water Company (Case No. 8228) and Solemint Water Company (Case No. 8229). There have been seven days of public hearing on the two investigations, consolidated with the five complaints. Respondents have been ordered to install certain plant additions, to initiate specific system improvements and to prepare a master plan for future growth. An interim hearing has been held to review respondents' compliance with the Commission's orders. Final hearings will be held after respondents' master plan is filed and has been reviewed by the Commission staff.

The five complainants appear as interested parties in the two investigations. Those investigations include, but are not limited to, the past service deficiencies cited in all five complaints. At the public hearing on March 9, 1966, none of the parties objected to a suggestion that the Commission continue to treat the complaints as part of the over-all problems covered by the investigations, rather than to hold all of the matters open. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Cases Nos. 8231, 8232, 8233, 8236 and 8237 are dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
