Public Utilities Code of the State of
California.

ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 69146, dated May 25, 1965, in this proceeding provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of C & M Truck Lines, Inc., for failure to maintain its tariffs on file with the Commission in conformity with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders. That decision also provided that the effective date of the order would be stayed in the event it

filed with the Commission before such effective date the required tariff filings.

On June 4, 1965, Allied Traffic Service, William H. Hitchcock, Agent, filed tariff revisions for C & M Truck Lines, Inc., to comply with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders, thereby staying the effective date of the order. Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 69146, supra, will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 69146, dated May 25, 1965, in Application No. 47106, is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
