

Decision No. 70562

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BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the County of Santa Clara, State of California, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at grade over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in connection with the Construction of a Road Connecting Capitol Expressway and Hillsdale Avenue, in the County of Santa Clara.

ORDER

The County of Santa Clara is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. EXA-55.7.

Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Expense of construction and installation of automatic protection shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be divided in the same proportion as the cost of construction is divided, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

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This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
