O R D E R

Modesto Interurban Railway is hereby authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Daly Avenue at Lapham Drive near Modesto in Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 28-1.9. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two additional Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material and placed to provide protection for traffic on Lapham Drive. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges the industry is in need of immediate service in order to avoid expensive delay in the operation of its plant. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
