OPINION AND ORDER

By these petitions, California Trucking Association seeks to have the commodity descriptions amended for various exception ratings named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (East Bay drayage area), City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (San Francisco drayage area) and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B (San Diego drayage area). These ratings are published as exceptions to the classification ratings otherwise applicable in the Governing Classification.¹ Petitioner asks that

The above-named minimum rate tariffs are subject to the provisions of National Motor Freight Classification A-8 (CAL) as governed by National Motor Freight Classification A-8, collectively referred to herein as the Governing Classification.

common carriers be authorized to establish in their respective tariffs such modifications as may be prescribed by the Commission's order in these proceedings, including relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code.

Petitioner proposes to amend these commodity descriptions so that they will be designated by reference to the particular item numbers of the Governing Classification wherein the commodities involved are described. Petitioner states that its proposal is another step in a program instituted by it under a general policy providing for tariff changes necessary to the provision of more definite and certain tariff descriptions, and to the establishment of a general tariff format compatible with pending and prospective innovations in electronic billing and rating procedures incidental thereto.

Petitioner declares that the issues involved in the tariff implementation of this general program were discussed in detail in Decision No. 6999+ in Case No. 5432 dated November 23, 1965, and that it has followed the same procedures generally as outlined in that decision and believes that the proposed revisions are reasonable and proper. Petitioner avers that it has no objection to, and encourages, the use of an extended effective date, as provided in Decision No. 6999+, supra, in order to protect the shipping public against inadvertent errors and omissions.

Copies of the verified petitions were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and carrier representatives on or about February 18, 1966. The petitions were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 24, 1966. No objection to the granting of the petitions has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and that the resulting minimum rates will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved. The Commission concludes that the petitions should be granted and that the proposed changes should be adopted to become effective not earlier than sixty days after the effective date of this order so as to afford an opportunity to interested parties to advise applicant and the Commission concerning those items which may require separate and further consideration. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B will be amended accordingly by the order herein. In order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carrier's Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B will be amended by separate orders.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 22, 1966, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the sixtieth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
