SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 70651 entered today in Cases Nos. 5441 and 5439 (Petitions for Modification Nos. 101 and 42, respectively) provided that commodity descriptions for various exception ratings named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B should be amended so that they will be designated by references to the particular item numbers of the Governing Classification wherein the commodities involved are described.<sup>1</sup>

The above decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by a separate order in this proceeding.
