ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On April 7, 1966, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, respondent, filed with this Commission a petition for immediate emergency rate relief in which it requested an ex parte order authorizing it to increase intrastate revenues by not less than \$14,900,000 annually.

On April 29, 1966, respondent in writing stated that it desired to withdraw said petition and requested an order dismissing the petition without prejudice.
