O P I N I O N

Applicant (hereinafter called Morris) is a highway common carrier authorized to transport general commodities, with limited exceptions, between all points on and within 20 miles of specified routes extending from Salinas and Kingsburg, on the south, to San Francisco and Redding, on the north. (Decision No. 60077, dated May 9, 1960, in Application No. 41777, as amended by Decisions Nos. 60275 and 62226.)

Morris requests an order suspending for a period of five months its highway common carrier authority to transport "Pre-fabricated buildings on low bed equipment, except transportation of such freight from Newark, on the one hand, to San Leandro and Fresno, on the other hand." The Newark-San Leandro and Fresno route is excluded from the requested suspension so interstate shipments can be interlined from these points to out-of-state job-sites. (Decision No. 68998, dated May 4, 1965, in Application No. 47520 and Decision No. 69749, dated October 5, 1965, in Application No. 47883.) This application merely asks that the suspension presently in effect be extended for another five months while Morris concludes negotiations for a long-term transportation contract.

The Commission finds that the granting of this application will not be adverse to the public interest. The application should be granted without public hearing.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Morris Draying Company, a corporation, is authorized to suspend for a period of five months, commencing June 1, 1966, its highway common carrier authority to transport prefabricated buildings on low-bed equipment, except transportation of such freight from Newark, on the one hand, to San Leandro and Fresno, on the other hand.

The effective date of this order shall be June 1, 1966.
