O P I N I O N

Mary G. Carr (as Mary C. Carr) filed this application for a household goods carrier permit. Her manager was given an examination, as required by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code. The manager failed to pass this examination. However, according to the staff member who examined him, he has an adequate knowledge of the hourly rates.

As required by Section 5135 a public hearing was held at San Francisco before Examiner Power on April 25, 1966, and the matter was submitted.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that applicant meets the requirement for issuance of a permit, provided that such permit is restricted to service between points within 50 constructive miles of her headquarters in San Francisco and to the established hourly and piece rates.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as provided by the following order.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission is authorized and directed to issue a household goods carrier permit to Mary G. Carr containing the following restriction:

"Applicant shall not perform any transportation service under this permit where either the point of origin or the point of destination is more than 50 constructive miles (as indicated by the applicable distance table) from San Francisco and shall be limited to the hourly or piece rates as prescribed in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B and supplements thereto or successive reissues thereof."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
